

## **Guide to Bicycle Storage**

Open Hours: Weekdays and Saturday 10:30am ~7:00pm

**%**Closed on Sundays, public holidays and year end, new year holidays (29<sup>th</sup> Dec.  $\sim$ 3<sup>rd</sup> Jan.)

#### © What to bring when retrieving your bicycle, etc.

- Personal Identification of person coming to retrieve the vehicle (Residence Card, Driver's License, Health Insurance Card, Student ID, etc.)
- ② Key for the bicycle, etc.
- ③ Storage Fee for Impounded Vehicle Bicycle ¥2,000 Motorbike ¥3,000

**%**Distance from Main Locations


JR Shizuoka Station ····approx. 20min. walk

Shizutetsu Shin Shizuoka Station ····approx. 10min. walk

Shizuoka City Hall-Aoi Ward Office ····approx.10 min. walk

#### <u> XBy bus</u>

A 5 min. walk after getting off at Naka-cho bus stop on the Miwa Oya Line/Abe Line/Inomiya Line/Seibu Junkan Line, etc. (riding from Shizuoka Station, Shin Shizuoka Cenova direction)



### Precautions

- 1 If you are unable to come and retrieve it within the retrieval period, you can send someone in proxy to do so.
- 2 If the retrieval period has passed
  If the bike in question has not been disposed of yet, although it may no longer be at the
  Bicycle Storage, it can be returned to you, so please contact us.

#### 3 If the impounded bike was a stolen one

If a theft report had been filed prior to the impoundment of the bike, the impoundment/storage fee may be waived.

Please notify the person in charge of this when you come to retrieve the bike.

Please make sure you have the following information: when and which koban (police box) the theft report was filed, and by whom it was filed.

4 If you have no memory of the bike

Sometimes a bike that was disposed of a long time ago reappears. Please contact us and let us know how you would like to handle the bike.

5 If you do not wish to retrieve the bicycle, etc.

Shizuoka City will dispose of it for you if you contact us.

However, in the case of disposing of motorbikes, the owner must personally return the number plate and make a declaration of disuse at the city office.

If a theft report had been filed for the bike, the owner must personally have it withdrawn at the police station.
