Cycling: Good for your health, good for the environment! More and more people are

using bicycles, not just for commuting and shopping, but

also for recreation. Bicycles fall into the category of "slow mobility". They allow the rider to soak in all the fresh air, sights and smells that people in cars miss out on, while at the same time giving you a sphere of movement much wider than people on foot. Why don't you give the bike life a try? We think you'll enjoy it!

Bike Life Pros:

- Eco-friendly: You don't need fuel, so it's easy on the environment.
- Healthy: It burns the same number of calories as things like running or swimming (an adult male burns energy equivalent to roughly one rice ball in 20mins).

Message from Mayor Tanabe:



Remember, cycling insurance is a legal requirement! Check the contents of your insurance plan.

Learn the rules before you hit the streets:

The 5 principles of bicycle safety.

- In general bicycles should ride on the road. You should only ride on the sidewalk in exceptional situations.
- Ride on the left edge of the road.
- When using the sidewalk, ride slowly on the side closest the road, giving way to pedestrians.
- Obey safety rules:
 - **Never do the following:** Cycle under the influence, ride with two people on one bike, ride parallel to another bike, ride without a light, ignore traffic lights or stop signs.
- Children need a helmet.

In pursuance of our goal, "Shizuoka: A City of Cycling on World Standards", the City of Shizuoka has been moving ahead with a variety of tangible, intangible, and psychological initiatives. Many of you have been making use of "Share Cycle PULCLE", which started in 2020, and the number of stations has increased to over 160. We will soon be entering prime cycling season. Why not go for a ride down the Pacific Cycling Route, designated a "National Cycling Route" last year? It's exhilarating, let me tell you! Let's kick Shizuoka into gear as a city for cycling!

Advice from the City of Shizuoka:

We recommend making a reservation as soon you receive your ticket. Analysis done within the city makes it clear getting a 3rd (booster) shot is effective at preventing Covid-19 infection, as well as the development of heavy symptoms.



Please continue to practice Covid-19 Countermeasures over Golden Week.

There is a fear of increased Covid-19 spread during the holiday period with the rise in human movement. Please be extra careful with upholding Covid-19 countermeasures when leaving the house. There has been a rise in Covid-19 cases with children who aren't able to be vaccinated. Let's protect our children from Covid-19.

*The number of dependent relatives, etc. is the number you reported for tax purposes on your end-of-year adjustment, tax report, etc.

*If you have 4 or more dependent relatives, the income limit increases by ¥380,000 for each additional dependent.



2. The yearly "notification of current circumstances" submitted every June will, in general, no longer be required.

*However, the "notification of current circumstances" will still be required for certain recipients.

*The city will send out instructions to those who are required to submit the above notification.

Hornets' Nests: Early Detection, Early Extermination! Extermination Applications:

Hornet's nests must be exterminated as soon as possible. Hornets can be found in residential areas, but because they are social creatures with a strong defensive instinct, they will not hesitate to <u>attack and sting humans</u> if they feel that their nest is threatened. It is essential to familiarize ourselves with hornets and their habits, in order to prevent such incidents.

Experts contacted by the city will exterminate <u>active</u> hornet nests in <u>private</u> <u>homes</u>. *Offices, housing complexes and agricultural land not applicable. In addition, depending on the positioning of the nest, extermination may not be possible, or may require an additional fee from the applicant.

Let's check around the house

Hornets love to nest in dry places protected from the wind. Check under the overhang of your roof, tree branches, inside the hedges in your garden, etc.

<u>Why is April~June the perfect period for extermination?</u> During that time, the Queen builds the nest alone. The Queen has little-to-no aggression, which allows us to get rid of the nest easily.
