New Exhibits from Fri 28 April

At the Historical Drama Museum (大河ドラマ館, *taiga dorama kan*), you can see costumes and accessories used during the shooting of scenes set in Sumpu (Shizuoka City), and view exclusive behind-the-scenes footage and interviews with actors from the show.

We will be changing up some of the exhibits and introducing a host of exhibits about Imagawa Ujizane and the Imagawa clan.

Open period: Until Sun 28 Jan 2024

Open hours: 9:00-18:00 (last entry at 17:30)

Where: Shizuoka Sengen-jinja Shrine Grounds (Miyagasaki-cho, Aoi-ku)

Entrance Fee: 400 yen; 200 yen for elementary to high school students (Pre-school-aged children are free)

Discount price for city residents: 200 yen; free for elementary to high school students *ID (drivers' license, health insurance card, children's card, etc.) required in order to use city resident discount
