

6. Afterschool Kids' Club

The "Afterschool Kids Club" (*hokago jido kurabu*) is an initiative that looks after elementary school children whose parents aren't at home after school due to work, etc., and nurtures them in a safe and wholesome environment.

*Depending on the number of applicants, entry may not be possible.

Open days: Mon-Sat (excluding public holidays and the year-end/new year period))

*Open during summer, winter, spring holidays, etc. Closed on Saturdays in Shimizu Ward (excluding Kambara Higashi and Yui).

Open hours: From end of lessons to 19:00 on days when elementary school is open

08:00-19:00 on days when elementary schools are closed.

Cost to Parents:

Aoi Ward, Suruga Ward, Shimizu Ward (Kambara Higashi and Yui): ¥9,500 per month

*¥14,000 for August, ¥12,000 for March

Shimizu Ward (excluding Kambara Higashi and Yui): ¥7,500 per month

*¥12,000 for August, ¥10,000 for March

Extended use (18:00-19:00) costs extra

*¥100 per use (max of ¥1000 per month)



Cost Reduction System

There is a cost reduction system in place for families with multiple siblings enrolled, and families with low income. See the enrollment guide for more information.

Deadlines for submission: Tue 31 Oct for primary selection; Wed 31 Jan 2024 for secondary selection

Where to get enrollment guides and application forms: Available from Mon 25 Sept at each club, Shizuoka City Social Welfare Council (Jonai-cho, Aoi-ku), Youth Affairs Division; Ward Office Childcare Support Divisions; Kambara Branch Office
