Get a health check once a year!

How to get a Health Check in Shizuoka City

- 1** Choose the check/screening you want to get and the medical facility you want to go to.
The content of the health check may vary depending on the medical facility. Make sure to check which medical facilities are conducting health checks.
- 2** Make a reservation directly to the medical facility that conducts the check.
Make a reservation by phone (in Japanese). E.g. "Shizuoka-shi no XX kenshin wo kibō shimasu/I want to get the Shizuoka City XX screening"
- 3** Go to the checkup.
Check this leaflet for what you need to take, and make sure to take those items to the medical facility on the day.
- 4** Receive the exam results
Receive an explanation about the exam results from the medical facility directly or by post (Japanese).

*All medical facilities conducting medical health checks follow the countermeasures against the novel corona virus (COVID-19).

Who can get a medical health check?

Shizuoka City Cancer Screening / Periodontal Disease Screening / Other Health Checks

Those who have a certificate of residence in Shizuoka City and **who are not able to receive a cancer screening, periodontal disease screening, or other health checks through their workplace.**

*Enrollees in medical insurances other than the National Health Insurance/Medical Care for Elderly People Aged 75 or Over can also receive the health check.

Health Checkup for the Prevention of Lifestyle Illnesses

Shizuoka residents who are enrolled in National Health Insurance or Medical Care for Elderly People Aged 75 or Over.

*Those who are enrolled in insurance other than those listed above should check with their insurance company.
